

A NEW PROJECT FOR HIS LIGHT FOR HAITI

The Mission School that we help to support in Haiti has need of a second story to be added to an existing building used as a classroom. With the enrollment well over 400 children now, the state is demanding more classroom space. There are several buildings used at present, including the tabernacle. Our artist friend, Isaac Bermudez, has created a model of the first floor now existing and he is going to build a second floor with Legos as money is contributed each week!

We are off to a GREAT start. After announcing it on Sunday, we received generous contributions and added the coins from the Haiti jar, giving us \$287.55 to get us going! Isaac will add a Lego piece to the wall for every \$3 contribution. Be sure to follow his progress as he now has 95 Legos in place. It is all displayed at the front of the sanctuary.

For our new people at church, there is a one page story of our involvement in this great ministry, His Light for Haiti, started here in Dover-Foxcroft about 12 years ago. Pastor Wawa, the liason there in Haiti, will be in Maine this summer and so wants to meet our people to thank us for our help through the years.
