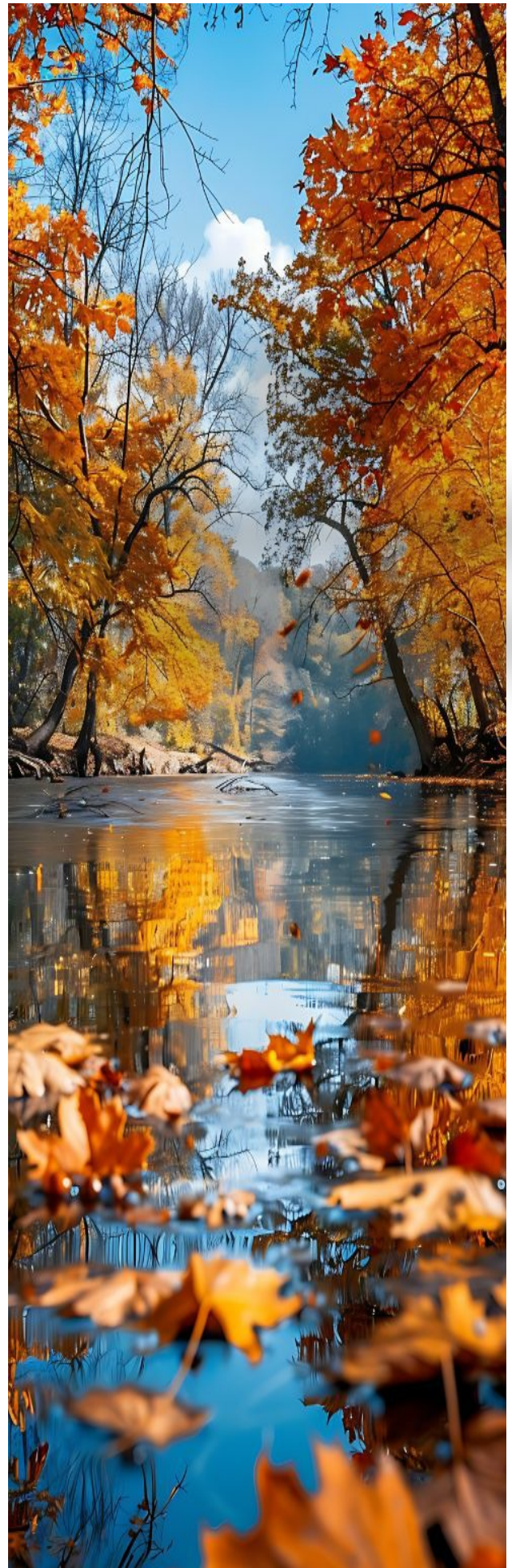

Through My Window

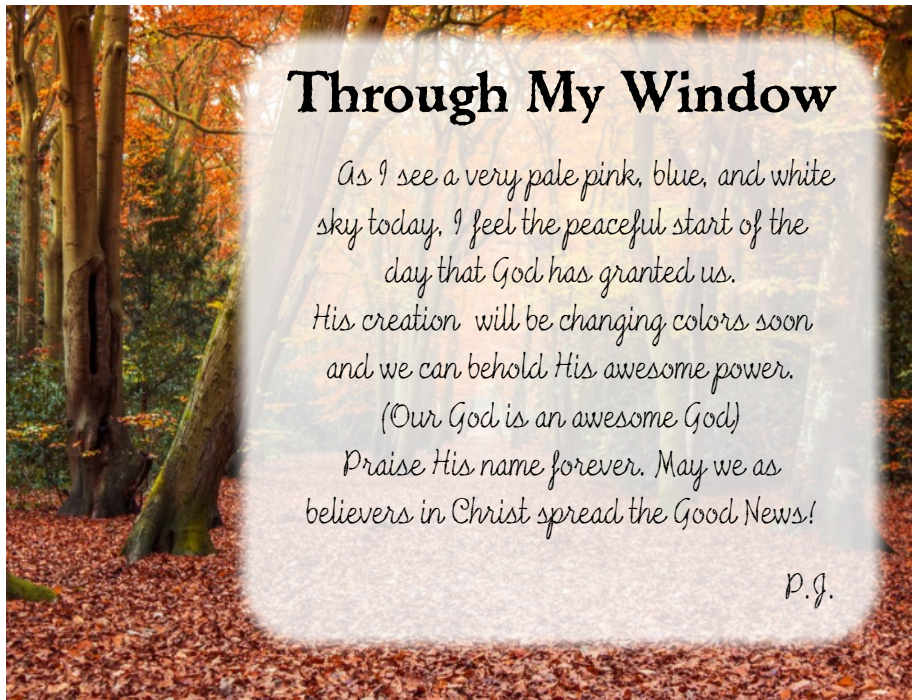
*As I see a very pale pink, blue, and white

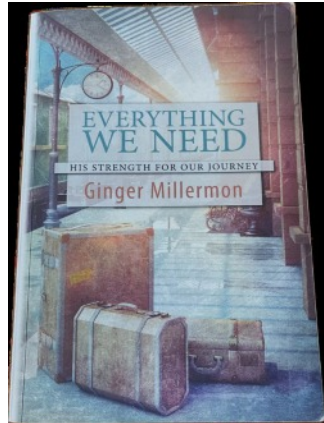
